In 1951, Women's Hospital was aptly renamed McLaren General Hospital to honor Ms. McLaren and the values she upheld throughout her life, including excellence, compassion and a commitment to one's community.

Today, McLaren is annually recognized as one of the top Integrated Health Networks in the nation. In addition, McLaren is one of the largest health care providers in the state, reaching nearly 50 percent of Michigan residents.
